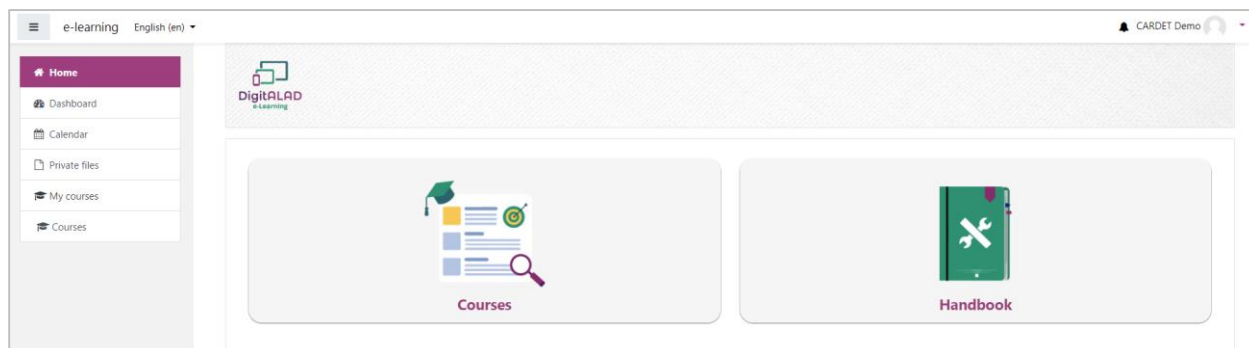
## Digital Adult Educators: Preparing Adult Educators for a Digital World

#### Self-guided learning through learning platform becomes fun!


We are always glad to see adults seeking for opportunities to improve their skills and competences! Adult educators can now access the DigitALAD learning platform which consists of a series of micro-courses across the full suite of digital competences they require to possess. All content is based on the European Digital Competency Framework for Educators (DigCompEdu) and covers all professional aspects of educators in modern societies.

In total, the micro-courses are divided into 5 categories and concern 22 digital competences! Each competence consists of a learning tube that trains you through interaction, questioning, problem-solving and critical thinking.



Users are guided through the content by answering quizzes, watching videos, discovering digital tools, or searching for information. Therefore, they become the creator of their own knowledge. In fact, they can access each micro-learning resource independently, according to their preferences. The learning process is not linear because each one of us has different learning needs.
